Meeting was called to order by Mayor Hadden at 7:00pm.

Privilege of the Floor

Ben Frevert, Rochester People’s Climate Coalition (RPCC), presented a power point presentation regarding Community Choice Aggregation (CCA). RPCC has been presenting the program to municipalities in the Greater Rochester Area. The coalition has partnered with NYSERDA to promote ways to reduce Fossil Fuel energy and encourage more renewable energy use. A third party, Joule Assets, would serve as administer of the program at no cost to the municipality.

The municipality would have to adopt a local law, hold a public hearing, several steps with the PSC, solicit bids, announce it to the residents and then all residents would be “opted in” (except ESCO customers) and stay in the program unless they “opt out”. A few surrounding municipalities are interested so far.

RPCC will provide a fact sheet from NYSERDA and a template of a local law the board can review.

Sean McAdoo, Chief, VFD asked if there were any questions regarding the 2018 Fire Protection Contract. Victor Fire Dept. won the RFP for Fire Protection Services. This Contract is without any paid firefighters. The Town Board and the Victor Fire Dept. are

still interested in forming a new Victor Fire District with the Fishers Fire District, but the FFD has not voted on the merger yet.

Deputy Mayor Crowley asked Chief McAdoo to explain what could/would happen in the FFD vote "no" on the merger or doesn't vote at all. Chief McAdoo provided several different scenarios. Deputy Mayor Crowley expressed his frustration citing the fact that the Fisher Fire District came before our Board last year and basically "begged" the Village Board to come to a vote and now, months later, the FFD still haven't voted.

The Board requested Chief McAdoo start advertising the part time administrative position they approved last year.

RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Trustees authorizes Mayor Gary Hadden to sign the Contract of Use and Access Town Fuel Management System as presented at a cost of the fuel (per gallon) plus six cents (\$.06) per gallon to the Town of Victor; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Trustees authorized Chief Sean McAdoo to sign the contract with the Victor Fire Department under the same terms and conditions as previously stated.
