PROJECTS REVIEWED:

- Lot 3, Meadow View, 6952 Timberstone Lane
Rick Kartes, builder, requesting adjusting conservation easement

Mr. Kartes explained the situation. The driveway was shifted seven feet for the homeowner to accommodate for the slope. This went into conservation seven feet and it wasn't notice until it was resurveyed.

Mr. Kartes proposed moving the conservation easement to the back and adding five additional square feet; bringing the back conservation easement in and squaring it off.

The conservation board said to ensure that the new portion of easement is the same type as the current easement. McMahon LaRue will do another description and show it on the instrument survey map.

Mr. Kartes should check in with the Planning Board to make sure the proper procedures are followed.

The conservation board had no issues with this.

- Dorchester Park site walk discussion

Members of the town board and conservation board took a site walk to Dorchester Park to look at conservation easements one and two. Chairman Matteson showed drawings he prepared of where the easements are supposed to be and summarized the site walk.

Chairman Matteson will contact the other boards and the town attorney to determine next step.
