- b. No report on the historical marker at the corner of Wagnum Road and Main Street Fishers to mark the site of the abandoned Fisher family cemetery
- c. A motion was made by Wilma and seconded by Chuck that we request that Barb Pippin be appointed by the Town Board as a member of the Cemetery Committee; Chuck seconded the motion; the motion carried
- d. The update of the cemetery brochure was tabled until our next meeting.

New Business:

- a. A re-enactment of notable people in the cemetery is an event that we would like to host in 2020. Bob has contacted Maureen McHugh, a victor resident active in the Schnacky Community Players. Maureen expressed a willingness to participate and help us find other participants. We will need to research historic characters to feature. Bob will contact review this with the Historic Advisory Committee and look for a fall 2020 date.
- b. Dillman Cemetery documentation. Bob Kelly will contact Betty McMahon of the Ontario County Historical Society to arrange a visit to the Dillman Cemetery.
